CBCS — Supplementary Examination

This is for general information that in B.Com. CBCS (Honours/General) course, according to clause 7.13 of CSR/64/17 dated 14/09/2017 of University of Calcutta, if any candidate fails to secure pass marks in one or more papers of a semester, that candidate may appear in those papers when the concerned end-semester examination will be held next time. There is no provision of supplementary examinations in CBCS system.

As for B.Com. Part-III (Honours/General) course, as the present batch of B.Com. Part-III students are unsuccessful candidates of the previous years, hence this batch is not a regular batch. According to CSR/22/19 dated 20/08/19 they may clear their backlog papers in Part-I or Part-II examinations when such examinations will be held next time.

As for candidates who appeared in B.A./B.Sc. Part-III (Honours/General/Major) Examination, 2020, according to CSR/30/13 dated 08/10/2013, all the previous supplementary examinations have been conducted in February, 2020 and results have already been published. As supplementary examinations cannot be held twice in a year, those will be conducted again in 2021.

According to CSR/54/09 dated 24/11/09 and CSR/123/10 dated 19/11/10 there is no provision of review for supplementary examination candidates.

Efforts will be made to hold these supplementary examinations in early 2021.
